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Overview

CoPE (Communities of Practice in Education) is an Erasmus + project, funded by the EU, which aims at developing, testing and implementing a free sources software, called PraxManager, destined to facilitate the monitoring and evaluation of the students' practical training in VET. The project is being implemented from September 2014 till August 2016.

Partners

The partners in the project are 6 VET colleges from Romania, Turkey, Denmark, Spain and The Czech Republic, providing education in various fields, including healthcare and 1 silent partner from Switzerland. These institutions are: FEG Iasi, Izmit Kanuni Anadolu ve Mezleki Lisesi, Aarhus Social and Healthcare College, IES Majada Marcial -Fuerteventura, Joan Marragal Institute- Badalona and Stredni Zdravotnicka Skola A Vyssi Odborna Skola Zdravotnicka Ceske Budejovice and Seed- Lugano.

Activities

During the project lifetime, the activities to be performed consist of: developing the Prax Manager software, testing it in real contexts, both nationally and transnationally- in blended mobilities, implementing it in daily activities of the partner schools, sharing good practices on the organization of the educational process and especially on the evaluation tools and methods during short staff training events.

Events

Between November 18th and December 1st 2015, 5 students from each partner country took part in a learning mobility, event organised in Badalona, Spain, Kocaeli, Turkey and Ceske Budejovice, The Czech Republic. Its main objective was to develop the personal and professional skills and competences of the participants, as well as test the PraxManager software in real conditions. Before the transnational mobility, the students had taken part in virtual mobilities organized in cooperation with the host institutions.
